As a service to Texas higher-ed art faculty and institutions, during 2020-21 and 2021-22, TASA launched two years of covid discounts (with some levels of membership free), while at the same time sponsoring two virtual conferences (members-only, free) with Award Speakers (cash stipends) and four online exhibitions with cash awards. TASA networking also includes its website (<a href="www.tasart.org">www.tasart.org</a>), including: Project Share highlighting practice and/or curriculum from TASA member schools, updated news/communications with THECB about the Texas Transfer Curriculum, updated Gallery Listings, and Job listings. As we progress into a post-Covid era, TASA must return to "business as usual," meaning face-to-face conferences (yea!) but yes, increased membership rates for 2023-24, so we will have the resources to continue the networking and professional development services we have begun!

A 2023-2024 Institutional Membership entitles member institutions to list TASA as part of their departmental profile and includes the conference fee and individual membership for one designated "institutional representative" with voting rights on all matters that require approval by the membership schools. Individual membership is for individual faculty members. Student memberships must be currently enrolled in a college/university with a valid Student ID card. All TASA memberships have full access to the TASA website (www.tasart.org). Attendance at the annual conference (October 19-21, 2023 hosted by Texas A&M University, Kingsville!) does require current membership in the Association with conference fee additional (except in the case of Institutional Representatives who are exempt from one conference fee and one individual membership).
